

# Seasonal Gutter Checklist

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A simple year-round routine you can do mostly from the ground. For anything off the ground, get matched with a licensed pro.

## Spring

- Clear winter debris and check for winter damage.
- Watch the next rain: does water reach the downspout, or spill over?
- Look for sagging sections or pulled-away brackets.

## Fall (the big one)

- Clear leaves once the trees are mostly bare.
- Check downspouts drain freely and away from the house.
- Consider guards if leaves overwhelm your gutters every year.

## After a big storm

- Look for overflow, dents, or detached sections.
- Check for blocked downspouts and pooling at the foundation.

## Before winter

- Make sure gutters are clear so melt can drain (ice-dam risk).
- Confirm downspout extensions move water well away from the house.

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
